


Matilda's World




A new Community Centre is coming!

Currently under construction, the multi-purpose Murnong Community Centre in Donnybrook is expected to open its doors early next year.

This will be a super-convenient addition to the range of community centres surrounding Matilda, further adding to the facilities and resources that help support and connect our community.

Matilda - and Donnybrook - is booming, so the two new kindergarten rooms (offering 66 places for three to four year-olds), Maternal and Child Health Services, community hall and kitchen, two meeting rooms for hire, and public community lounge with mini-branch library, will certainly be well received by our rapidly expanding community.

The Centre will be delivered by the City of Whittlesea Council, and their Chair Administrator, Lydia Wilson, said about the project: "The Murnong Community Centre will be an accessible and inclusive facility providing residents with the support services they need from birth through to their senior years."

She also said; "Having this centre close to home will reduce the need for Donnybrook residents to travel long distances to access essential community services," which is especially true for Matilda residents as the Murnong Community Centre is just around the corner!
